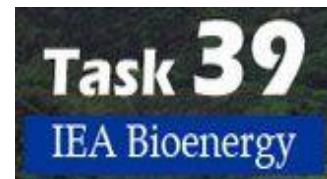

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Biofuels Policies in South Korea

- **With regard to biodiesel implementation**, Korea Ministry of Energy announced to increase biodiesel blending ratio from **3% to 5% until 2030** by increasing 0.5% every 3 year. It is a mandatory measure.
- Very recently Korea government announced the **Net Zero Carbon Target by 2050**. Bioenergy is expected to take an important role.
- To realize the target, Korea Ministry of Science and Technology will prepare **comprehensive R&D plan on 8 major technologies including bioenergy**.
- Detailed R&D plans of each technology will be prepared by the end of this year. The projects will start from 2023 and continue until 2049.
